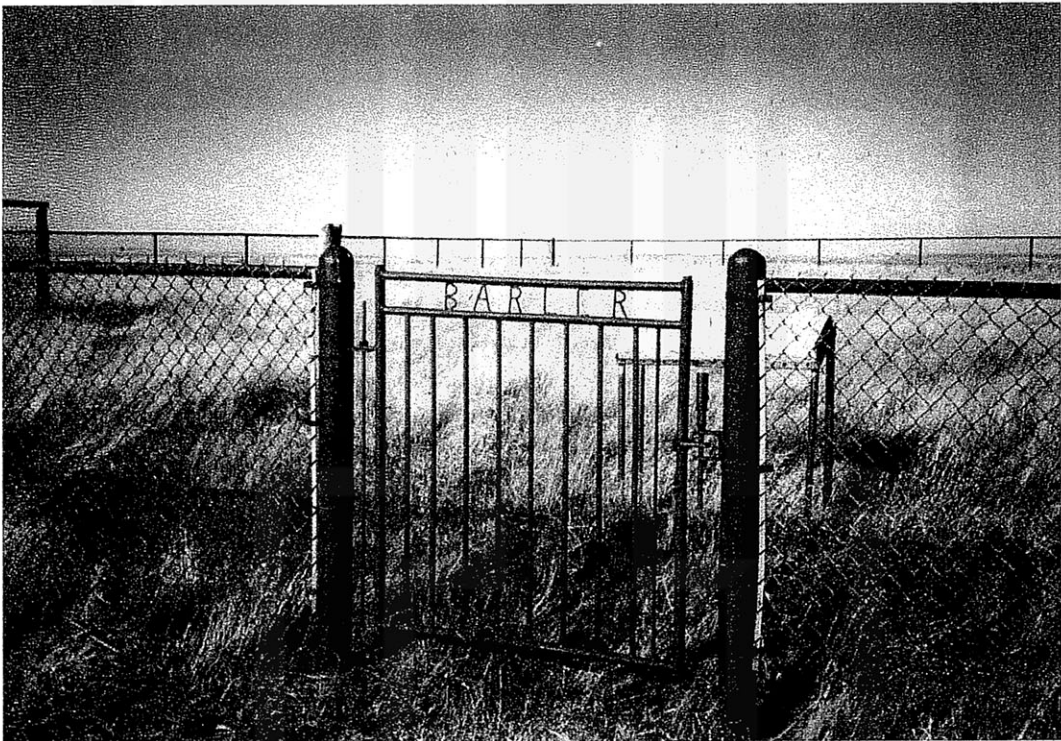

BARLER CEMETERY

S23-T2-R24

The Barler Cemetery is five miles east and one half mile north of Elmwood. It was named for James S. Barler, who died in 1905. Ada Barler, wife of James S. Barler, deeded the ground to the school board of District #73, for the purpose of a public burial plot. The deed was filed for record on the 27th day of October 1915. There are 13 headstones. There is a marker on a stand, with 22 names on it.



BETHANY CEMETERY

S21-T4-R21

This cemetery is located two miles east, one mile north and half mile west of Bryan's Corner, (Junction of US 83 and State 3). The cemetery is on the south side of the road. V. V. Wilson was the secretary in 1931 and until his death. W. C. Bryan was president at the time the cemetery blueprint was drawn. The first grave was a baby from the family of Moon (Myrtle, daughter of John Moon.) The child was originally buried on the north side of the section line and later moved when the cemetery was started. On lot 55 there are several members of the Holt family. These are unmarked except for a concrete marker with Holt family and no date. One of the oldest graves is 1906. There are about 223 graves in this cemetery, at least five of which are soldiers of this country.
