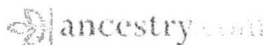

I, S. C. S. Durham do hereby make application to the Commissioner of Pensions for a pension to be granted me under the Act passed by the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved April 7, 1913, on the following grounds:

I enlisted and served in the military service of the Confederate States during the war between the States of the United States, and that I did not desert the Confederate service, but during said war I was loyal and true to my duty, and never at any time voluntarily abandoned my post of duty in the said service; or (that I was in the service of the State of Texas during the war, to protect said State against the Indians and Mexicans for more than 6 months.) 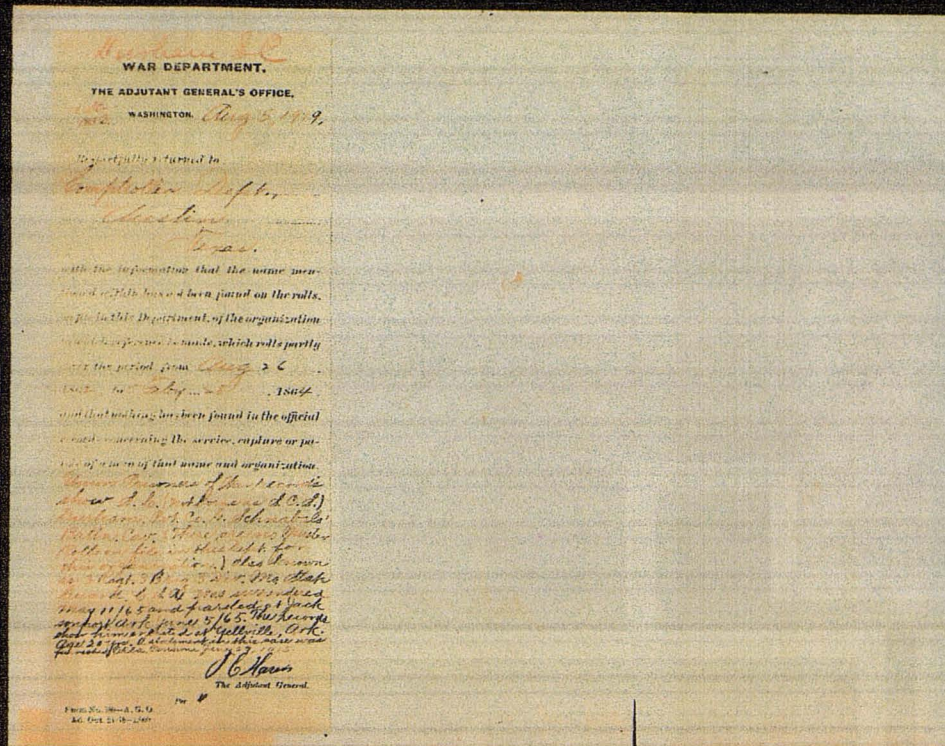

Your attention is directed to Chapter 62, Acts of the Regular Session of the thirty-first Legislature, and Article 6271 A. C. S., providing for manner of making application for Confederate pension. It is necessary that application be made before the county judge of the county in which applicant resides, and where it is necessary for applicant to go outside of his county to obtain proof of service, such depositions may be made by any officer authorized to administer oaths, and such evidence may be accompanied by affidavits of county judge where witnesses reside that they are of trustworthy character and entitled to credit.

You have submitted the evidence of only one witness in making proof of service, while the law requires two. This witness failed to state fully the nature of his knowledge as to your service.

I am enclosing herewith application and blank for deposition of witnesses living out of your county. On receipt of these properly filled out your application will again be given consideration.
