# Building Complex Issues

Of the 33 employee responses, all 33 were proud of Schlumberger's effort to integrate the landscape. Of those 33, 28 believed the effort was successful, 1 did not believe the effort was a success, and 4 were uncertain.

When asked what time of year the site's landscape was at its best, the majority of employees responded Spring. Of the remaining employees, 6 believed the site was at its best all year, 5 answered Spring and Fall, and 2 said Fall.

Regarding hazards and inconveniences throughout the site landscape, 9 of the 33 replied that there were none. Hazards, inconveniences, and improvements observed by employees are noted on the plan.

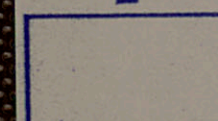
## GENERAL PROBLEMS:

9. Wisteria is in trees and needs pruning
10. Chlorotic wisteria and liriop
11. Browning of carolina jessamine
12. Dead sumacs
13. Walkway corner plantings are worn
14. Nature Trail not maintained enough
15. Irrigation systems and heads need checking
16. Lack of clear regional habitat conservation plan
17. Smoking on the boardwalks
