Dear Mrs. Brown:

The project for which the Texas Education Fund was used was the mailing of both County and State Voter Guides prior to the May 6th Primary. These guides were mailed to registered voters, one per household, in the cities of Angleton, Clute, Freeport and Lake Jackson. The League borrowed the registration lists from the County Tax Office. Members were assigned lists and put street addresses on labels preprinted with "Registered Voters", the city and zip code. These labels were then affixed to the folded Voters Guides and taken to the Post Office for mailing by bulk permit.

The League of Women Voters of Brazosport mailed 10,026 Voters Guides. The cost of mailing these was \$494.00. We received \$484.50 from the Texas Education Fund. We were over by \$9.50 which was taken from our Voter Service budget.

I'm sorry but we have no receipts, as the Post Office failed to give us any.

U. S. Postage fees for mailing of May 6, 1972 Primary Voters Guide. One Guide to each household where there is a registered voter(s). Guide contains information on all candidates running in the Democratic and Republican primaries, information on precinct conventions, election calendar and precinct voting stations.
2. Project purpose. Short ~~xxx~~ term. However, this same information may be used in November, 1972 election.

Guides have previously been distributed by local firms to their employees. Some homes would receive two and three copies, other homes, with registered voters, would receive none. This method was used as the local league did not have the necessary funds to mail Guides.
