was Captain of Co B In Battle of Perryville Ky. In Battle of Missionary Ridge at Chattanooga Tenn. also Bullock Creek. Next Siege of Vicksburg, I was in Command of Regiment. Col. Harris was killed at Baker's Creek leaving me in Command of Regiment.

This Siege lasted 47 days.

I carried Regiment to Atlanta Ga. There Disbanded until exchanged - then under Joe. E. Johnson, from Dalton to Atlanta. Thence with Genl. Hood. Atlanta to Nashville Tenn. will gladly refer you to Genl. Joe. Wheeler of Ala. also to no of other brave & noble Comrades that are past & gone. Disbanded at Charlotte N.C. & close of the war
