



**Biblical Bits** 

Things you probably knew about the Bible anyway:

- 1. Is the Bible a Sacred Book? No. It is a collection of sacred books. more of a library really. Within its covers there are seventy-three books written by dozens of authors over a period of a thousand years.
- 2. What is the Old Testament? The first forty-six books of the Bible. In different literary styles they recount the special relationship (i.e. Covenant or Testament) that Israel had with Jahweh. The oldest of these books was written about 900 B.C.. the most recent about 150 years before the birth of Jesus.
- 3. What is the New Testament? The 27 books of the Bible that focus on Jesus, who brings us into new, more intimate Covenant (Testament) with God. The oldest of these books. the early Epistles of Paul, were written about twenty years after the death of Jesus. The remaining books were written after the death of the last Apostle (e.g. the Gospels, Acts. Revelation and most of the Epistles).

- 4. Does everyone agree on the number of books in the Bible?
- No. Jews count twenty-four books in the Hebrew Bible (our Old Testament). They exclude 1 and 2 Maccabees, Tobias, Judith, Baruch. Luther excluded Judith, Revelation. the Epistle to the Hebrews and the Epistle of James.
- 5. Did St. Paul write all the Epistles of St. Paul?
  - No. He wrote 1 Thessalonians, Galations, 1 and 11 Corinthians, Romans, Philippians and Philemon. The other Epistles were probably written by people using Paul's name to show their allegiance to the great saint.
- 6. What clue do we find in 1 Timothy that Paul was not the author? Almost certainly Paul could not have

passed the test he prescribes for new bishops, i.e. "not quick-tempered". It was Paul who called the Galatians "fools". A hot-tempered Paul wished his Jewish foes would slip when using the knife of circumcision and castrate themselves (Gal.5/2).
