




### CONFEDERATE KENTUCKY TROOPS

### 6th Regiment, Kentucky Mounted Infantry

6th Infantry Regiment was organized at Cave City, Kentucky, in November, 1861, and included in Cofer's 1st Kentucky Infantry Battalion. Its members were raised in the counties of Nelson, Spencer, Hardin, Franklin, Barren, Green, Allen, Anderson, Bullitt, and Simpson. It became part of the Orphan Brigade or Louisville Legion. This regiment lost 108 killed and wounded at Shiloh, sustained 18 casualties at Baton Rouge, then was active at Vicksburg. During the war it was assigned to General Hanson's, Helm's, and J.H. Lewis' Brigade. It fought with distinction at Murfreesboro and Chickamauga, then saw action in the Atlanta Campaign. In the fall of 1864 the unit was mounted, and aided in the defense of Savannah and the campaign of the Carolinas. It lost seventeen percent of the 269 engaged at Murfreesboro and 220 saw action at Chickamauga. The unit totalled 263 men and 221 arms in December, 1863. The 6th surrendered with the Army of Tennessee on April 26, 1865. The field officers were Colonels Martin H. Cofer and Joseph H. Lewis, Lieutenant Colonel William L. Clarke, and Majors Thomas H. Hays and George W. Maxson.

### Civil War Burials in Fairview Cemetery, Pampa, Texas

I. Introduction, by John A. Mead, Lovett Library, Pampa.

Information on the Civil War burials in Fairview Cemetery was obtained by two people. Most of the work was done by Mrs. Sandra Barnes of Amarillo, Texas, who was interested in the burials of former Confederate soldiers. John A. Mead of Lovett Library in Pampa added a few men who served on the Union side.

Research on each person in this notebook involved research on <ancestry.com>, the LDS website <familyhistory.com>, and other websites. Key sources of information were Civil War databases on <ancestry.com> and several other websites; and public family trees on <ancestry.com> and also on <rootsweb.com>. The Ancestry website also had data from the 1890 U. S. veterans' schedules for Union veterans (and in some places for Confederate veterans as well); and from the 1910 U. S. census, which asked whether a person had served in the Union or the Confederate army or navy.

For each person in this notebook there is general information from family trees, where such exist; census returns, particularly those during the Civil War Years; and, if these could be found, death certificates for each person. Also included is information on the Civil War service of the individual, including information on the unit in which the person served, if this could be determined.

In the majority of these cases I am relatively certain of both the Civil War Service and of the unit in which the individual served. In the case of persons number 13 and 15 I am certain that they did serve, but I am not certain of the unit in which they served. In the case of number 9, Henry Ledrick, the family tree written by a descendant says that he saw service, and I include this person for that reason. I am not entirely certain of her evidence, however.

I make no claims that these 15 men are the only Civil War veterans who served and are buried in Fairview. There may well be others that we missed.

Union service: private in Company F, 60th Illinois Infantry Regiment.

### 7. William Manson Hughey

Born 1 August 1834 in Newton County, Georgia. Died 1905 in Gray County, Texas. Buried in Lot 8, Block 19.

Confederate service: captain in 8th Arkansas Artillery Field Battery.

8. Benjamin Franklin JAMESON

Born 31 March 1839 in Montgomery County, Missouri. Died 14 December 1920 in Gray County, Texas.

Buried in Lot 20, Block 6.

Confederate service: drafted in Union County, Missouri, but unit in which he served is unknown.

### 9. Henry Ledrick

Born 14 June 1842 in Alsace, France. Died 19 February 1905 in Roberts County, Texas. Buried in Lot 28, Block 3.

A family tree on Ancestry says that our Henry was the same as the Henry Loederick who, according to as Ancestry database, was drafted into Union service in Buffalo, Erie County, New York in 1863. However, the estimated date of birth of this Henry Loederick was 1839, and our Henry was born in 1842, so I am not sure whether this is right. An Ancestry database also has a Henry Ledrick who served with the 13<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment in 1861-1863. Was this the 13<sup>th</sup> New York Infantry Regiment? Is this Henry the same as the Henry Loederick of the first record? I am not certain.

### 10. Andrew Jackson Meers

Born 7 May 1842 in Cherokee County, Georgia (gravestone says 1840). Died 19 April 1927 in Wichita County, Texas. Buried in Lot 4, Block 19.

Confederate service: captain in Company C, 21st Arkansas Infantry, Green's Brigade.

### 11. Anthony L. Purvis

Born 4 February 1844 in Robertson County, Texas. Died 16 April 1923 in Gray County, Texas. Buried in Lot 7, Block 19.

Confederate Service: corporal in Company F, Timmons' Regiment, Waul's Texas Legion.

### 12. Pryor Lea Shelton

Born September 1847 in Rankin County, Mississippi (gravestone says 1848). Died 26 November 1924 in Hutchinson County, Texas. Buried in Lot 12, Block 11.

Confederate service: private in Writ Adams' Regiment, Company F, 1<sup>st</sup> Mississippi Cavalry Regiment.

#### 13. David Madison Skaggs

Born 29 August 1848 in Alabama.

Died 13 November 1940 in Carson County, Texas.

Buried in Lot 28, Block 7.

In the 1910 census question asking for Union or Confederate service, David Skaggs' entry says CA, indicating Confederate service. The unit in which he served is not certain. He apparently lived in Coosa County, Alabama during the war years, and his father and a brother served with the 30<sup>th</sup> Alabama Infantry Regiment. It is possible that David M. also served in this regiment.

#### 14. David Hale Smith

Born 19 October 1844 in McNairy County, Tennessee. Died 17 April 1911 in Gray County, Texas. Buried in Lot 16, Block 7.

Confederate service: private in McCord's Frontier Regiment, Texas Cavalry.

#### 15. Clement Richard Tisdale

Born 6 October 1846 in Bowie County, Texas. Died 15 June 1915 in Gray County, Texas. Buried in Lot 13, Block 5.

Confederate service, but which unit he served in is uncertain. Four brothers served in the 33<sup>nd</sup> Regiment of the Texas Cavalry (Crump's Battalion, Mounted Volunteers), and perhaps Clement R. Tisdale served in the same unit.
