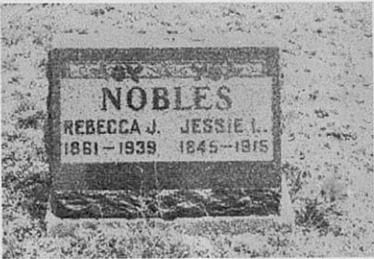

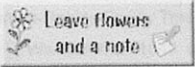

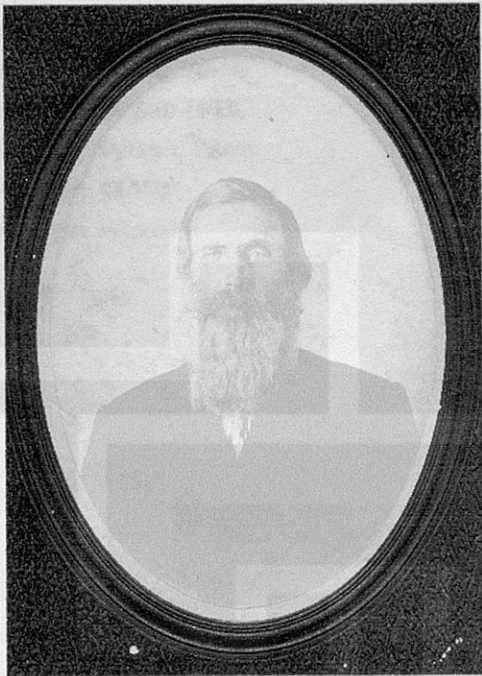

## Widow's Application for Confederate Pension

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

County of Dallas

I, Mrs. Rebecca J. Nobles do hereby make application to the Comptroller of Public Accounts for a pension, to be granted me under the Act passed by the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved April 7, A. D. 1913, on the following grounds:

I am the widow of Jesse Nobles deceased, who departed this life on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Sept, A. D. 1915, in the county of Dallas in the State of Texas.

I have not remarried since the death of my said husband,\* and I do solemnly swear that I was never divorced from my said husband, and that I never voluntarily abandoned him during his life, but remained his true, faithful and lawful wife up to the date of his death. I was married to him on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, A. D. 1880, in the county of Young in the State of Texas.

My husband, the said Jesse Nobles, enlisted and served in the military service of the Confederate States during the war between the States of the United States, and that he did not desert the Confederate service. I have been a resident of the State of Texas since prior to January 1, A. D. 1910, and have been continuously since a citizen of the State of Texas. I do further state that I do not receive from any source whatever money or other means of support amounting in value above the sum of \$300.00 per annum, nor do I own in my own right, nor does anyone hold in trust for my benefit or use, estate or property, either real, personal or mixed, either in fee or for life, of the value of one thousand dollars, exclusive of the home of the value of not over \$2000; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any other State, or from the United States, or from any other source, and I do further state that the answers given to the following questions are true:

1. What is your age? 64
2. Where were you born? Cook County Texas
3. How long have you resided in the State of Texas? 64
4. How long have you resided in the county of your present residence? 16
5. What is your postoffice address? Tex line
6. Did your husband draw a pension? No If so, give his file number —
7. What is your husband's full name? Jesse Nobles
8. In what State was your husband's command originally organized? Florida
9. How long did your husband serve? Not sure If known to you, give date of enlistment and discharge. enlisted Mar. 30, 1863 at Ocala Fla. He was ordered discharged by order of Gen. Finigan the date, do not know, cause on account of sickness
10. What was the name or letter of the company, or number of the regiment in which your husband served? If he was transferred from one branch of service to another, give time of transfer, description of command and time of service, (If applicant's husband was a pensioner, give his file number, which is evidence sufficient for proof of service.) Capt Cary's Co. 9<sup>th</sup> Regt Florida Inf
11. Name branch of service in which your husband served, whether infantry, cavalry, artillery, or the navy, or if commissioned as an officer by the President, his rank and line of duty, or if detailed for special service, under the law of conscription, the nature of such service, and time of service. none
12. Have you transferred to another any property of any kind for the purpose of becoming a beneficiary under this law? No

Wherefore your petitioner prays that her application for a pension may be approved and such other proceedings be had in the premises as required by law.

private, Co. I, 5 Regiment Georgia  
Reserves, Confederate States Army,  
enlisted April 16, 1864 in Pulaski  
County for the war. He was paroled  
at Greensboro, N.C., May 1, 1865 in  
accordance with the terms of a Mil-  
itary Convention entered into April  
26, 1865.

The records also show that one  
Jesse Nobles, pvt. of Capt. Gary's  
Co. (G), 9 Regt. Florida Inf., C.S.  
A., enlisted Mar. 30, 1863 at Ocala,  
Fla., age 21 years. On roll dated  
Apr. 30, 1864 he was reported "Dis-  
charged by order of Gen. Finegan."  
The date, cause and place of dis-  
charge is not stated.
