

1692 Legal Instrument

Given at Bristol 21. These are to certify that on this 21. day of November in the fourth year of the Reigne of King William and second Mary over England & Annoq Day 1692 James Baskerville and Benjamin Willoughby both of this City Gentlemen came personally before me Edmund Arundell Esq. Mayor of the same City and made voluntary Oath on the Holy Evangelists of God That the paper writing herewith annexed is a true Copy of a Bargaine & Sale bearing date the fourteenth of December 1662 made from Peter Knight to a Richard Fildesing Merchant of One thousand & a Tree of land lying and being on the South side of the great Winkwomare River in the County of a Virginia All which on request I do hereby certify under my hand and Seale of Mayoralty of this City the day & yeare first above written.

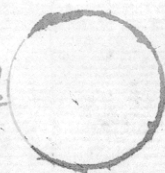

Be it known unto all men by this present that I Peter Knight
of Witkoto Mato Doe for mee my heires and Assignes Give grant
bargaine sell And for a valuable Consideration received have given
granted bargained & sold unto Richard Gooding of Bristol Northant
One Thousand Acres of Land lying & being on the South side of
great Witkoto Mato River at head of the said River which Land
was granted to mee by patent & bounding as followeth Northwesterly
upon the River and Easterly upon the Swamp that in Kingsthorpe
on and Westerly upon the great Swamp ^{and} Southwesterly into the Woods at
Duble Lough - to the marked Tree the said Richard Gooding To
have & to hold the above said Land unto him and his heires Assignes
for ever And further I the said Knight Doe warrant the above
said Thousand Acres of Land unto the said Gooding his heires or
assignes from every person or persons and further I the said Knight
Doe bind mee my heires or assignes to acknowledge the said Land
in Court unto the said Gooding his heires or assignes as witness
my hand & Seal the fourteenth of December 1662.
