I aim to leave for Calif next Sun P.M.

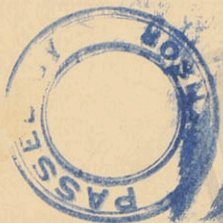
to be with Nola she wanted dad & I both
