Nov 9, 1941

Written Oct 25 or about

We are having some more cool  
weather - at least a breeze most of  
the time -

Have you been well? I haven't  
weighed for a month but am feeling  
fine - my job is running the tractor  
most of the time - I do not work  
too hard and hope I do not have  
to - We did have to work on the  
dock unloading boxes crates the other day  
3 days 11 hours per day at night - 6 PM  
to 6 AM. . 3 of us unloaded 30 tons of  
Lead 50 lb bundles in 5 hours - we  
picked it up pitched or <sup>put</sup> laid it on  
small movable platforms to be picked up  
by a crane



I was not ~~so~~<sup>too</sup> tired after doing my part.

I have heard from Nola since she moved - I hope she stays well.

yes I write to Sally - she waited 3 weeks once to write so if it happens again - I will not understand it - And I will quit writing. ~~myself~~

We have not had a clipper out for several days - about 10 but should have one out by Nov 7 -

I received ~~of~~ the glasses - They are not quite like I wanted but are fine - They will be alright as the lens are alright.

I may not stay here over 9 months as I can then work in Honolulu at the same wages - So I may leave then - I will let time take care of that though



If you do not hear from me every week or 10 days it is because it has been that ~~time~~ much time between clippers

We do not have any good souvenirs of this place - only coral and shells but I will bring some back.

My job is about the same I like it very well - I do not know how long it will last - That is they just have so many buildings to put up - so when that is done I ~~may~~ have to work at something else. But at my increased salary they do not cut a man's pay after giving a raise -

Well I've been here 3 months - I can leave anytime - our contract is not binding in that respect. I would be unable to work for this company only if I decided to quit - if a person had sickness at home he could leave anyth. a
