constructed, and because the two first toes of the fore feet are attached to each other, as far as the end of the last phalanx. The thumb is separated from the other toes, and has no claw. This laft character is not peculiar; for the Virginian and murine opoffums have the fame kind of thumb, but none of them have united phalanges.

These animals seem to vary among themfelves, as appears from the figures of the male and female. They are of the fize of a fmall rabbit, or of a very large rat, and are remarkable for the excessive length of their tail, the prolongation of their muzzle, and the form of their teeth, which alone would be fufficient to diflinguish them from the murine and Virginian opoflums, the rats, and every other species of quadrupeds.
