Comrades,

I was born in
Warren County Tenn.
in 1845 I joined the army
at Shreveport La. Jan. 1863.
I joined W. B. Benson Co.
old General Holmes
body guard until the
fall of Little Rock and
Pine Bluff and we had one
or two little fights on the
Mississippi river with
gun boats and then
we was consolidated
with the Mo. regiment
then we guarded prisoners

at Shreveport. La in the
winter of 1864 in the
spring of 1865 we had the
battle of Mansfield and
Pleasant Hill we surrendered
on the banks of Red river
below Shreveport where
Gen. Green was killed.
Comrade I was young and
that is about all the details
of the war I can remember
