Know all men by these presents that we, Henry Hampton, Edmin McGinnis, James Jorden are held and firmly bound unto David Ruffner, Ob. Fuqua, Fleming Cobbs & Carrol Morris, gentlemen Justices of the County Court of Kanawha County in the just and full sum of five Hundred dollars, which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs &c., jointly and severally firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this 14th the day of Nov. 1804.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Henry Hampton is appointed by the Court Guardian of Henry Hampton Jr., Anthony Hampton, Richard Hampton, and Nelly Hampton sons and daughter of the above bound Henry Hampton during the minority of the aforesaid sons and daughter, Now if the said Henry Hampton shall discharge the duty of Guardian to his said wards and also annually settle and account with the said court, for, and concerning the profits of the said wards, and true inventory of all such estate of the said Wards, as shall come to his hands or possession or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him, and in all matters and things touching the said Guardianship shall conduct himself agreeable to law, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

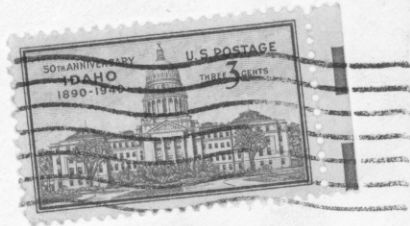
