I enlisted in Boston Bowin County our Capt was Martin Glover Company's Battalion and when we reorganized at Corinth Miss we were the fifteenth dismounted cavalry I was elected 1st Sergeant of Co E and served as such during the war. I was in the first battle at Elkhorn Ark afterwards crossed the Miss River and went in to KY and then back into La campaign I in the battles of Murfreesboro, Chickamauga and all the battles under Bragg Johnson & Hood. was captured at the fall of Atlanta when the Army marched to Jonesboro. went to Chicago prison (Camp Douglas) and was discharged from prison the 17th day of June the year the war ended our first Capt was Martin Glover, Sec Bil Ponder 3rd Jim Dixon. 4th Chas Leigh. Two of our Capt was killed in battle (Dixon and Ponder)
