PROPOSED LOCAL PROGRAM 1961-1962

CURRENT AGENDA: Study of the structure, functions and policies of the Brazos River Harbor Navigation District.

CONTINUING RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Support of Council-Manager form of city government.
2. Community action on the proposed Master Plan for Freeport.

The proposed program is submitted to you by your local Board. It was formulated from suggestions and discussion by the members in general meetings. Four other possible items were mentioned and considered, but a study of our Navigation District was much more widely favored than the others. The four not recommended items are:

1. Financial structure and policies of Brazoria County.
2. Study of the needs for and means of providing a county hospital.
3. Study of the need for street improvement in the city of Freeport,
4. Study of our county Welfare Department.

At the annual meeting on March 13, it will be the responsibility of the members present to decide whether to adopt the Local Program as proposed, which may be done by a simple majority vote, or whether to adopt one or more of the not recommended items. The latter will require a majority vote to consider and a two-thirds vote for adoption - if our proposed by-law change is adopted. Otherwise a two-thirds vote for both consideration and adoption of any not recommended item will be necessary.

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

The following proposed amendments are submitted for your consideration in order that our local By-laws may be consistent with State and National By-Laws: NOTE: Underlined words reflect the proposed changes.

ARTICLE V, Sec. 1. Enumeration and Election of Officers. The Officers.... shall be a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President... The President, the First Vice-President... elected in even numbered years. The Second Vice-President and... in odd numbered years. (To allow a Second Vice President)

Sec. 3. The Vice Presidents. The two Vice-Presidents, in the order of their rank, (Make plural the vice presidents)

ARTICLE VII, Sec. 3. Quorum. 20% of.... constitute a quorum.... (Changed from 10%)

ARTICLE IX, Sec. 3-d. Recommendations for Current Agenda... but not recommended by the Board.....

- (1) The Annual Meeting shall order consideration by a majority vote.. (changed from two-thirds)

Sec. 4-a The Continuing Responsibilities may be amended by a majority vote... (Changed from two-thirds)


