We do have this buckle set, however, in a 5/8" buckle at the same price which is \$5.00 each plus 10% tax. Dear Miss Gibbs:

We wish to thank you for your order for our #11-Belt, we will put the belt in work and will have same to you within two weeks. At the present time we do not have a silver buckle in a \$5.00 range. One of our most popular buckle sets sells for \$8.25, this includes Federal Tax. The belt that you have ordered will take a 3/4" buckle, and where buckle set is not ordered we will put on a commercial buckle with the leather loop.

In reference to our previous letter stating that our #145 Buckle set in a 5/8" size, will state that in our opinion a 5/8" belt does not stand up as well as a 3/4"; therefore, we made this change. It is also much easier to find a 3/4" buckle than the 5/8" buckle. Should you at some future date wish to use the silver buckle, we are sure that you will be pleased with this belt and especially the change to 3/4" buckle.

To make this clear, you are getting 1-1/4" belt tapered at each end and to fit a 3/4" buckle.
