I will send you notes from time to time with suggestions on how to project the character of James Bond (or any stereotyped English character). This shall be the first of same.

1.) In a commercial, don't say, "phone RIverside 7-8321...", Say, "telephone" or even "ring up" if that is a common British expression.

2.) After giving the weather, refer to the weather "back home". "In London, it's naturally foggy and 67 degrees.", etc. Use this sparingly.

3.) Don't use American slang...use British slang. "Ruddy", "governer", "old boy", "old chap", "top hole", "good show", "cheerio", "old girl", "dashing", "smashing", "motorcar", "Motorbike", "bobbies", "mods", "rockers", "I say!".

4.) Use more Oxford English in your delivery. You tend to say "<u>afternoon</u>". Try for "<u>awfternoon</u>". Enunciate clearly "not sevenny-nine degrees" but "seventy nine degrees."

5.) Use "the James Bond Program", not the "James Bond Show."

6.) Read about all the English groups and be conversant about all of them. The kids will be asking you how well you know them. I believe you told me you knew them all.

7.) Comment occasionally about how different Dallas is from London. Specifically: Are the cab drivers more polite, is the skyline different? What similarities are there? Are you glad to be here? Why?

8.) Develop a feature (probably with a produced intro) in which you point out and play the number one song in London this week. (Trade papers will have listings. Can your relatives mail you a few records for this purpose?)

9.) To all conerned -- Let's develop a weekly "tea time with James Bond". Possibly each Friday, at 4:00 PM, invite listeners to Statler Coffee Shop to have tea with J.B. We ought to be able to do this very inexpensively.

10.) To all concerned -- Have receptionist write down questions from listeners and forward them to J.B. to be answered while he is on the air. We've had several during the first few hours. "Are you really from England?", etc.

11.) To all concerned -- For possible future use, feed this question to J.B. and have him give the following answer. Tape record both by means of a

brief air check. Retain tape in Manager's file.

Question: "Are you the same James Bond that appears in the movies?"

Answer: "No, I am not the same James Bond that appears in the movies. He is an actor named Sean Connery. My real name is known only to my superior "M" and, of course, Her Majesty the Queen. James Bond is my undercover name and my number is double-oh eight".

b.) GBM proposed that we bring in Shirley Eaton for a press conference. No one agreed. It was discarded.

c.) MIL will contact Dick Potter to see if we can obtain his gold Rolls Royce. GBM may assist.

d.) Weaver will consider obtaining a toy briefcase made by Mattel that is akin to that carried by J.B., what with secret compartments, et al. These will be given to ad people to - 2

promote James Bond.

e.) James Bond's show ingredients should be of such a nature to suggest the fictional character James Bond. Some of this has already been mentioned in my recent memo directed to KLIF's James Bond.

For instance, the deejays would say, "Today, KILT'S James Bond is keeping Neal Masterson under constant surveillance."

i.) James Bond should receive phone calls from foreign capitals. Presumably these would be from agents passing on information to them.

j.) A contest could be held in conjunction with James Bond. The prize would be a trip to the Bahamas to visit the set and filming of "Thunderball".

k.) <u>Esquire Magazine</u> -- See the current issue for a generous spread of James Bond and "Thunderball".

1.) The English flag should be displayed somewhere at the station when James Bond is on the air.

m.) James Bond should eat, particularly in Houston, at English restaurants such as The Red Lion or Sonny Look's Sir-Loin House.

n.) Scheduling -- When the girls and car have been obtained for James Bond, a schedule will have to be mapped out for maximum exposure. I would suggest that in the case of KLIF, 3 appearances a day would be the maximum. In Houston, possibly a few more due to the air shift. The car should fly small English flags from the front fenders and signs should be mounted on the air.

o.) Use our old suntan contest gimmick and award a prize for the person who comes to the studio with the best suntan forming 008.

p.) Contest to win a date with James Bond.

q.) Why not spend a few dollars on sweatshirts which would contain the message "KILT 008". These should be in children's sizes for give-aways to the children of agency people.




