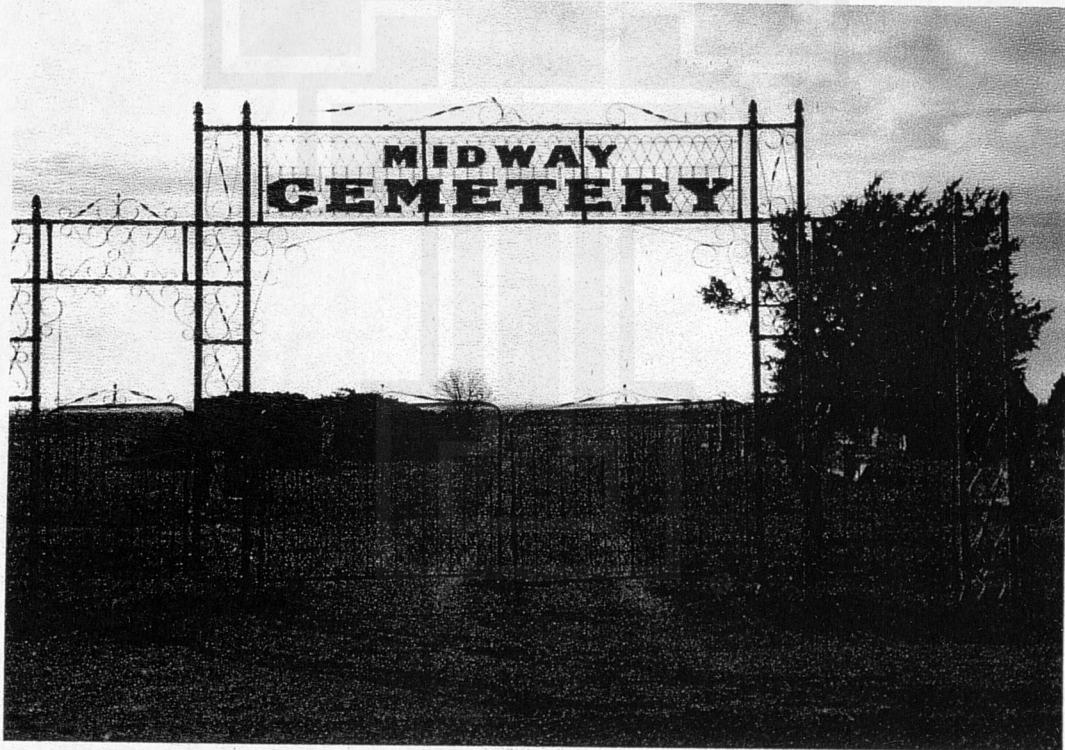

FLORIS MIDWAY CEMETERY

S19-T5-R22E

This cemetery is one mile north and a half-mile west of Floris town site. This road is one mile south of US 64. It is on the south side of the road. In the early days it was called Midway because it was halfway between Beaver, Oklahoma and Liberal, Kansas. In 1905 Walter C. Fincher, his brother W. H. Fincher and John Dorman donated four acres of land for burial purposes. Later as the community of Floris developed, the cemetery became known as Floris Cemetery. The first burial there was 1905. In 1931 the Greenough Homemakers Club had twenty-five cement markers made for unmarked graves.
