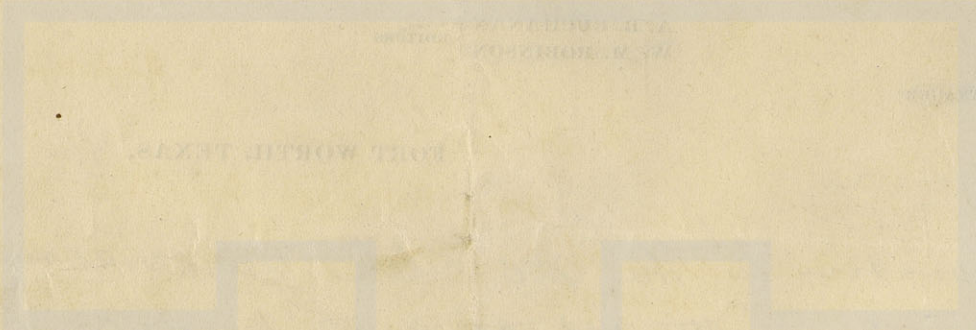
FORT WORTH, TEXAS, 8th 1903

I was sworn in to the 100 State guards about April 1861 and served in the 1st Co a Picardes Co first Regiment Walker Regiment Jeff. Thompson. Brigade ^{General} Infantry. Price was disbanded about Christmas the same year served a my time out.

I entered the Confederate service about July 1862 served in Hatcher's Co of Hestchens Regiment 10000 under Marmaduke's Cavalry until the latter part of 1863 I was on the in the Bloomfield fight and some skirmishing was ordered against in both services. I surrendered to the federal the latter part of 1863 and never was in service any more as I was under bond.
