That finished up the rest of that Marble cake I made but I was glad there was some custard left. I may bake a cake tonight or tomorrow for tomorrow but I don't know I guess I will just wait and see. You said to remind you to send me a Baylor catalogue or requirement deal or whatever you call it. About 12 more days of school and we will get out for the Christmas Holidays. When do you leave there for the holidays? It is nearly 4:45 and it seems like I never leave school go to Dennis's, the plant, etc. and get home before about 5 o'clock.

I guess it is getting mighty late to start doing any Christmas shopping but I always end up starting and rushing around town after school is out for the holidays to do all my Christmas shopping.
