

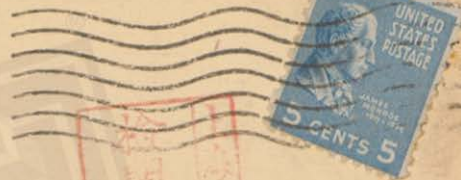
I went to Calif when Nola boy
