

PROCLAMATION

BY THE

Governor of the State of Texas

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

The Texas League of Women Voters is sponsoring the observance of "Atomic Energy Week" November 16 - 22, 1947. The week will be used to further the educational program and to inform the public of the League's stand on atomic energy control. Plans have been formulated for open forums, showing of films, and similar projects which will acquaint the public with their program.

The League of Women Voters is devoting its energy to a thorough public education program on the economic and social, as well as military, issues of atomic energy and the importance of international control as essential groundwork for future action.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Beauford H. Jester, Governor of Texas, do hereby set aside and proclaim the week of November 16 - 22, 1947, as

in Texas.
