Ezzie and I are teaching five miles from Muleshoe on Clovis Highway. This is a four teacher school & I am principal. Ezzie primary. I believe she was Arthur's first teacher. We live in the teacherage it is a nice five room modern home we like our work here fine.

The summer has been dry but our farm is irrigated and we have a good crop on it.

My brother Brady and another sister Mrs. Sadler live here too

We are all that is left of a family  
often children so we enjoy being  
near enough to visit often.

I would love so much to visit  
Wellington and see every one, no  
school can ever be so dear to me  
as Wellington. We are always glad  
to see anyone from the old  
home town.
