Uncle Stephen called last night and I think that they are going to work something out for Mother to come on Friday night and spend the night in Dallas and then he plans to drive her back and they may go through Waco so she could see the campus. We will check with them at the wedding and see what their definite plans are.

I do hope that you are having a good week.. I do believe that all of the pansies are going to make it. I hope that we will have some good sunshine before too long but not one plant has died yet. We really do have ~~a~~ green thumbs.

I will get out in the rain now and mail this letter. Take care and don't study too hard.
