I received a letter from
Mrs. Jaquard yesterday -

gift when she came to see
us. She said to tell you
"hello". Raybay has a
meeting at the Hospital
to-morrow - a staff meeting.
To-morrow night is the wedding

of one of my S. D. girls &
Rayboy & I are going
there. It's at 8:30 at home
so I'll wear my metal
lace dress, I think. To-mor-
row morning I must go to
town & get a gift. - I think
I'll just get 6 madiera
napkins - they are pretty.
I was going after dinner
to-day before afternoon
office hours, but Rayboy
had two calls he had to
make. Saturday with the
Drs. are to have a staggy
dinner somewhere & Rayboy
is going.
